SPRINGFIELD, Mo. – Bank of America provided a \$10,000 sponsorship to Habitat for Humanity of Springfield, MO (HFHS) to assist with a home rehab. Funds will be used to rehab a current three-bedroom HFHS property in Springfield’s Zone 1 for a local family.

When the home rehab is complete, and the partner homebuyer is qualified to purchase the home after completing the homeowner empowerment courses “Tools for Life”, and the required sweat equity hours, the rehabilitated home will be purchased at a 20-year, 0% interest mortgage.
