- **Poker Dealers – 20 Volunteers**
 - Volunteers will serve as dealers to 8 person tables during the poker tournament
 - Proper training and knowledge of Texas Hold 'Em poker is critical. Training will be provided prior to the training night – TBD location and time. Training will also be required the day of the event at 4:00 p.m. Volunteers MUST be available to attend training sessions to serve as dealers.
 - MUST BE 18 YEARS TO PARTICIPATE
 - Arrive by 4:00 p.m. finished by 11:30 p.m. *as tables consolidate, volunteer dealers will be able to leave for the night.
- **Registration Table – 3 Volunteers**
 - Volunteers will assist with pre-registered participants and on-site registration
 - Need ability to multi-task and keep a smile if things get stressful
 - Arrive by 4:00 p.m. finished by 6:30 p.m.
- **50/50 Ticket Seller – 2 Volunteers**
 - Volunteers will sell 50/50 tickets during the tournament to players and guests
 - Must be comfortable selling tickets and asking guests to participate
 - MUST BE 18 YEARS TO PARTICIPATE
 - Arrive by 4:30 p.m. finished by 9:30 p.m.
- **Prize Lottery Ticket Seller – 2 Volunteers**
 - Volunteers will sell 50/50 tickets during the tournament to players and guests
 - Must be comfortable selling tickets and asking guests to participate
 - MUST BE 18 YEARS TO PARTICIPATE
 - Arrive by 4:30 p.m. finished by 10:30 p.m.
- **Food Table – 5 Volunteers**
 - Volunteers will assist with serving food to guests
 - Arrive by 4:00 p.m. finished by 7:00 p.m.
- **Clean Up Crew – All Volunteers**
 - While your shift might end prior to the event ending, it would be appreciated to have you stay around to help with various clean-up projects!
- **Dessert Crew**
 - Can't help during the event? Send a dessert with another volunteer to be served at the tournament!
