

2017 Outdoor Makeover Rules

Drawing for the Outdoor Makeover will be held at the twelfth annual Tool Belts & Bow Ties event on Friday, March 24, 2017. Ticket holder's name must be listed on the ticket. Ticket holder need not be present to win. Winners not present will be contacted Monday, March 27, 2017. Winning ticket and valid ID must be presented in order to claim prize.

Cash, check and major credit cards accepted for entry fee. Acceptable credit cards include: MasterCard, Visa and Discover. Make checks payable to Habitat for Humanity of Springfield, MO. In the event that non-cash payments are not cleared for payment, the ticket becomes ineligible. Tickets are non-refundable. An organization may not purchase a ticket in its name, nor can anyone purchase a ticket and put it in the name of an organization. Only individuals are eligible to win. Tickets may not be sold to persons under the age of 18. It is required that ticket sellers advise adult ticket buyers not to write the name of a person under the age of 18 years on the ticket due to the requirements of the Public Trustee Act.

The odds of winning are dependent on the number of valid entries (maximum 1,000). Lost tickets will be voided and not valid in the drawing. In the event a ticket is voided, extra tickets will be provided in numbers 1001-1500. Ticket control will be handled by finance/accounting department of Habitat for Humanity of Springfield, MO, and is subject to audit at any time.

Winner is responsible for paying taxes on the prize, if any. Habitat for Humanity of Springfield, MO and Habitat for Humanity International will not be held liable for the taxes. Prizes are as listed. No cash substitutions for prizes. Prize is transferable, but must be installed at one address in Greene, Christian, or Webster counties.
