## Habitat for Humanity of Springfield, MO and Lowe's volunteers build up their communities during National Women Build Week, May 5-13, 2018: *A new construction build begins in Habitat's Legacy Trails Neighborhood in Springfield's Zone 1*

**SPRINGFIELD, Mo.** – More than 110 volunteers will join Habitat for Humanity of Springfield, MO (HFHS) to help a local family build their future Habitat for Humanity home. Friday's build is part of Habitat for Humanity's National Women Build Week, May 5-13, 2018.

Now in its 11<sup>th</sup> year, National Women Build week, an initiative created by Habitat for Humanity and Lowe's, has brought together more than 117,000 all-women construction volunteers to build or repair more than 4,500 homes. This year, Lowe's donated nearly \$2 million to Habitat for Humanity to support the 2018 National Women Build Week, which is set to take place in 300 communities nationwide.
